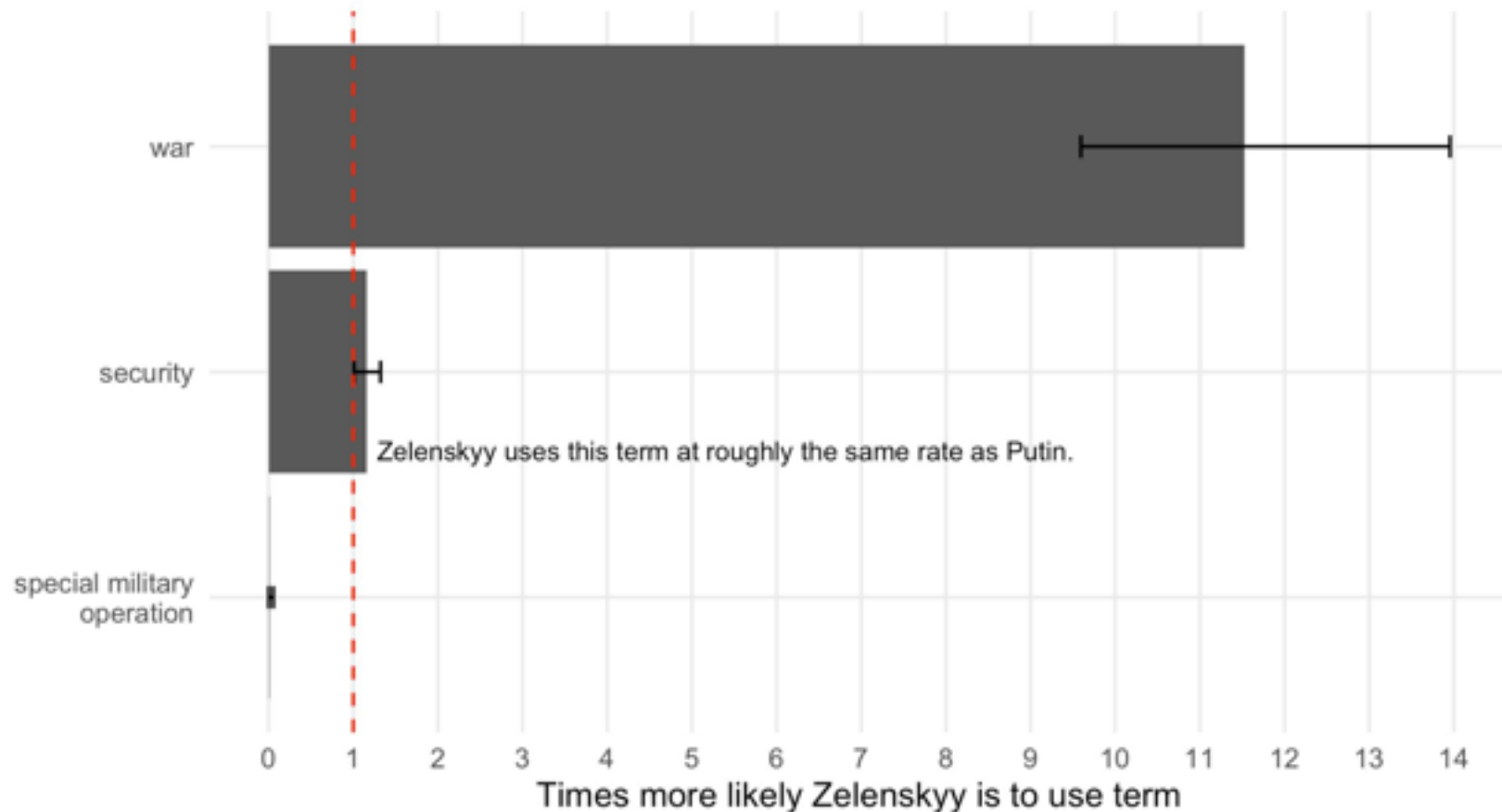
## Zelenskyy published more press releases than Putin after full-scale invasion

30-day moving average

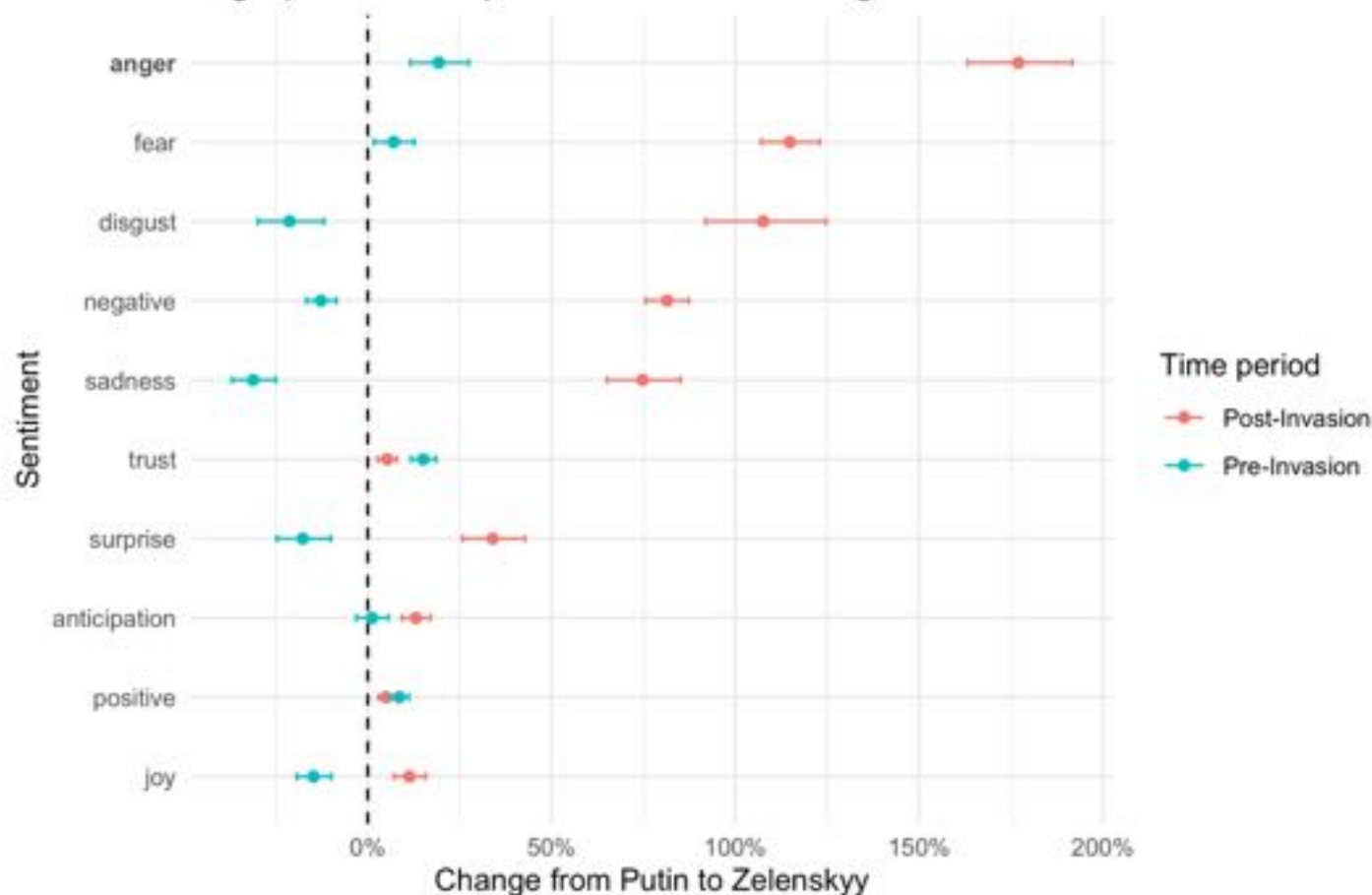


# Zelenskyy is 11.5 times more likely than Putin to use the word "war"
